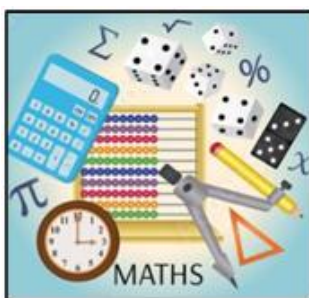
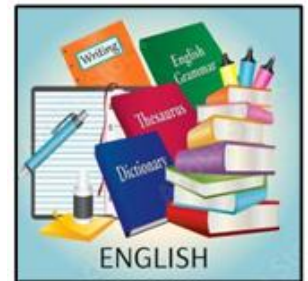


Oak Class Spring Curriculum Overview

English We will begin by writing a descriptive narrative about the yeti and its mountain habitat, using powerful vocabulary. Linking to our geography learning, the children will also create a factsheet about Mount Everest. After half-term, we will write a recount from the perspective of Hillary or Tenzing and finish the term by creating a persuasive leaflet encouraging people to look after our planet.



Maths In Maths we will start Spring 1 looking at methods to solve multiplication and division statements and explore division and its relation to multiplication. After the half term, we will explore length and measure, fractions and mass and capacity. There will be plenty of opportunities for explorative learning.
