Screenwise Children CIC/ Smartphone free childhood parent meeting **Wednesday 12th November -6.00pm- 7.00pm**



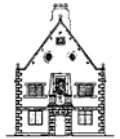

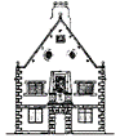

Willow Class



This week in Willow Class we have done lots of maths work exploring different measurements. We have been exploring height using the words shorter and taller, looking at weight with balance scales, seeing if items are lighter or heavier and looking at capacity by filling cups full, half full and empty. In literacy we finished our unit on Only One You thinking about how we are special and unique. During understanding the world, we looked at how we get to school and how we can travel safely on the pavements and roads. In outdoor learning this week we planted daffodil and tulip bulbs, we will be observing them to see the changes over the seasons.

Chestnut Class



Chestnut children have had fun writing and drawing their Traction Man comic strips this week, and then worked hard to demonstrate all their learning in their first "hot write" of the term. They completed their STEM project by evaluating their baby bear chairs. We started the next part of our Discover theme, contrasting modern toys with Victorian ones. The children used their science knowledge to compare the materials used as well as considering how toy designs have changed. Everyone enjoyed sharing their own toys before testing their skills with some Victorian style ones. In Maths, both Year 1 and Year 2 have been using their knowledge of number facts to learn about fact families and related facts.

Oak Class

In Oak class this week we have been looking at Viking Gods as part of our history topic. We have continued with our English work on "The Journey". This week we have used a writing scaffold to write our final diary entry 'A Day in the Life of Refugee Child.' In Maths, we are learning our 4 and our 8x tables as well as comparing numbers to 10,000 using greater than, less than and equals. Today we have had our Paceball lesson, which was amazing and everyone got involved. Pink team scored most goals with four and, white team and black team tied by scoring three each. In science We have been learning about light and how materials are dull or shiny and how they reflect light.

Hawthorn Class



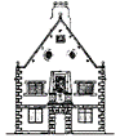
It's been a fantastic week of practical learning, imagination, and discovery in Hawthorn! In computing, they discovered that the main purpose of web crawlers is to create an index of the web, helping search engines to retrieve relevant information. To bring this to life, the children became 'web crawlers' themselves – searching the school for different items and recording their locations. In science they stepped into the shoes of Ancient Egyptian embalmers by mummifying tomatoes! Now, they are eagerly waiting to see the results in 70 days, when the mummification process will be complete, and the tomatoes will be ready to wrap in toilet roll! In Maths, the children explored factors, multiples, and prime numbers, while in English, they used their creativity to write museum placards describing ancient Egyptian artefacts.
