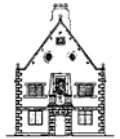

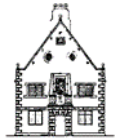

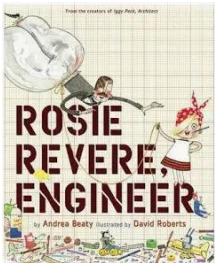


Willow Class

We also been inspired by the work of Christopher Wren to have the courage to build a new community - and to be courageous ourselves as we performed his story in our class assembly on Friday. Alongside this, the children have begun enthusiastically rehearsing for our production of *Peter Pan*, practising their lines, songs and stage directions in preparation for the performance. Hawthorn Class



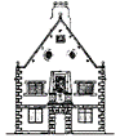

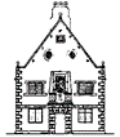
